I have only the vaguest recollection of seeing Dzuro, I think once, in the lift lobby on the day in question.

I have no recollection of anything other than an inconsequential exchange of "pleasantries."

Dzuro considers that my asking questions about the PIP that he himself drafted

constitutes "provocation"?
